

## School visit requirements

**RIO TINTO NATURESCAPE KINGS PARK** is a unique excursion environment where students can explore, imagine, learn and connect to nature. Follow these simple procedures and everyone will enjoy a successful and safe visit. Thank you.

**PROFESSIONAL LEARNING** Teachers are required to attend a FREE site introduction session before their first excursion. This requirement is to ensure student safety and maximise the learning experience.

**BE PREPARED** Check your excursion itinerary and drop-off/meeting point before the day of your visit. If you need any help contact the Bookings Office (Monday, Tuesday + Friday) on (+618) 9480 3638 for assistance.

**SUPERVISION** The school supervisory team retain full responsibility for students' supervision, welfare, safety and behaviour at all times.

**STAY SAFE – SUPERVISION RATIOS** Natural hazards, including sharp sticks, rocks, water and wildlife are a natural part of our environment. Student safety is best managed by ensuring that the minimum adult to student ratios are in place:

### Primary Schools

Kindergarten	1:4
PP-Year 2	1:5
Years 3 – 5	1:6
Years 6 – 7	1:8

### Secondary Schools

Years 7 – 9	1:10 – 15
Years 10 – 12	1:30

**SMALL GROUPS** Planning for small group activities will enhance the student experience, promoting a sense of freedom and imagination, and help to ensure student safety.

**TAKE RUBBISH WITH YOU** There are NO BINS here. Encourage students to bring a waste-free lunch and please take any rubbish home.

**WATER** An excursion to *Rio Tinto Naturescape Kings Park* is NOT TO BE CONSIDERED A WATER-BASED ACTIVITY AND SWIMMING (INCLUDING SUBMERGING OF HEAD AND BODY) IS NOT PERMITTED. The water is not suitable for drinking or ingesting in any manner. Wading to knee depth only is encouraged. Drinking fountains are provided on site.

**WHAT TO BRING** This is an outdoor venue. Students and adult helpers should be dressed and prepared for the weather conditions. Sports uniform, closed-in shoes, sunhats, sunscreen, insect repellent, water bottles and lunch. There are no places nearby to buy hot drinks or lunches.

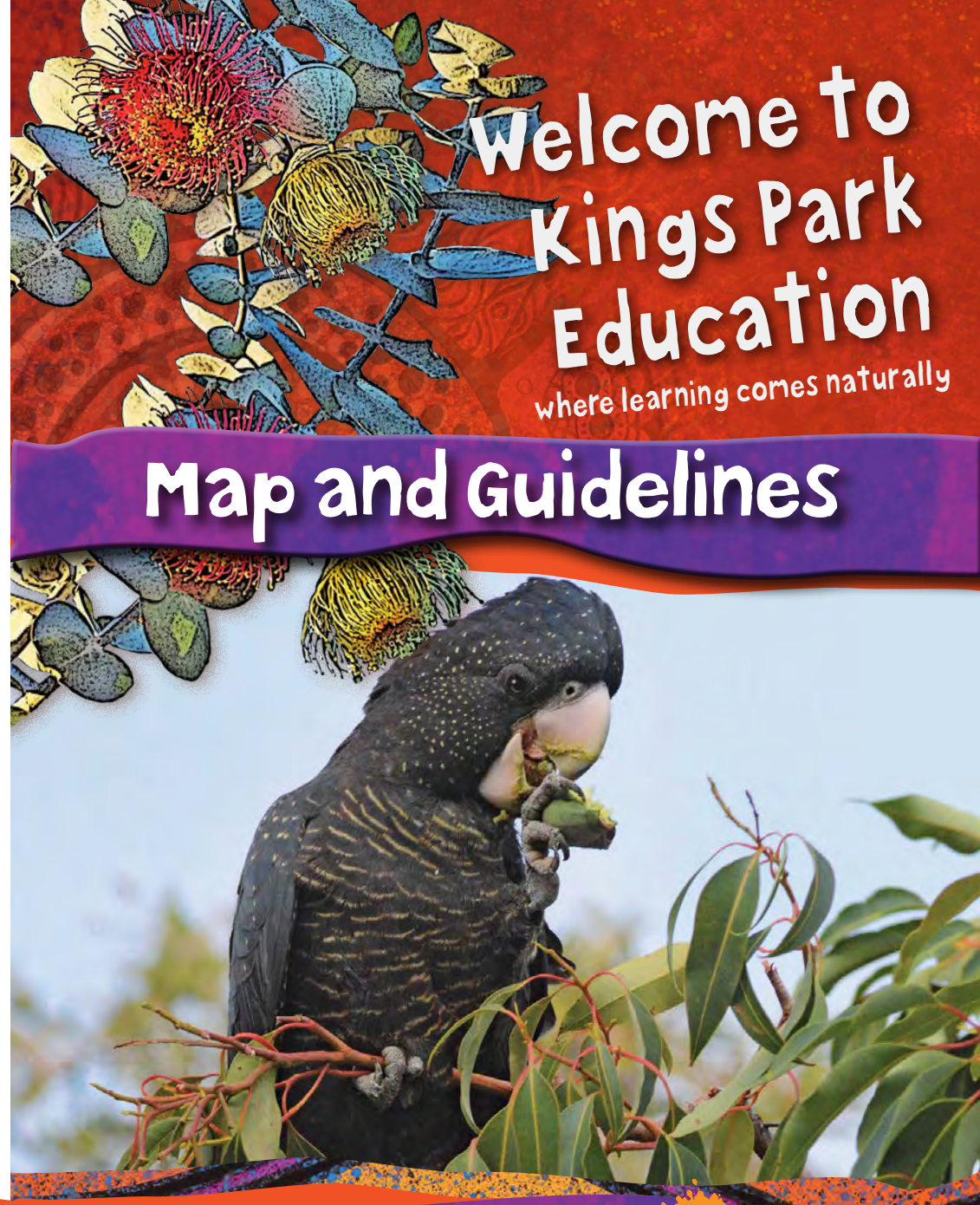

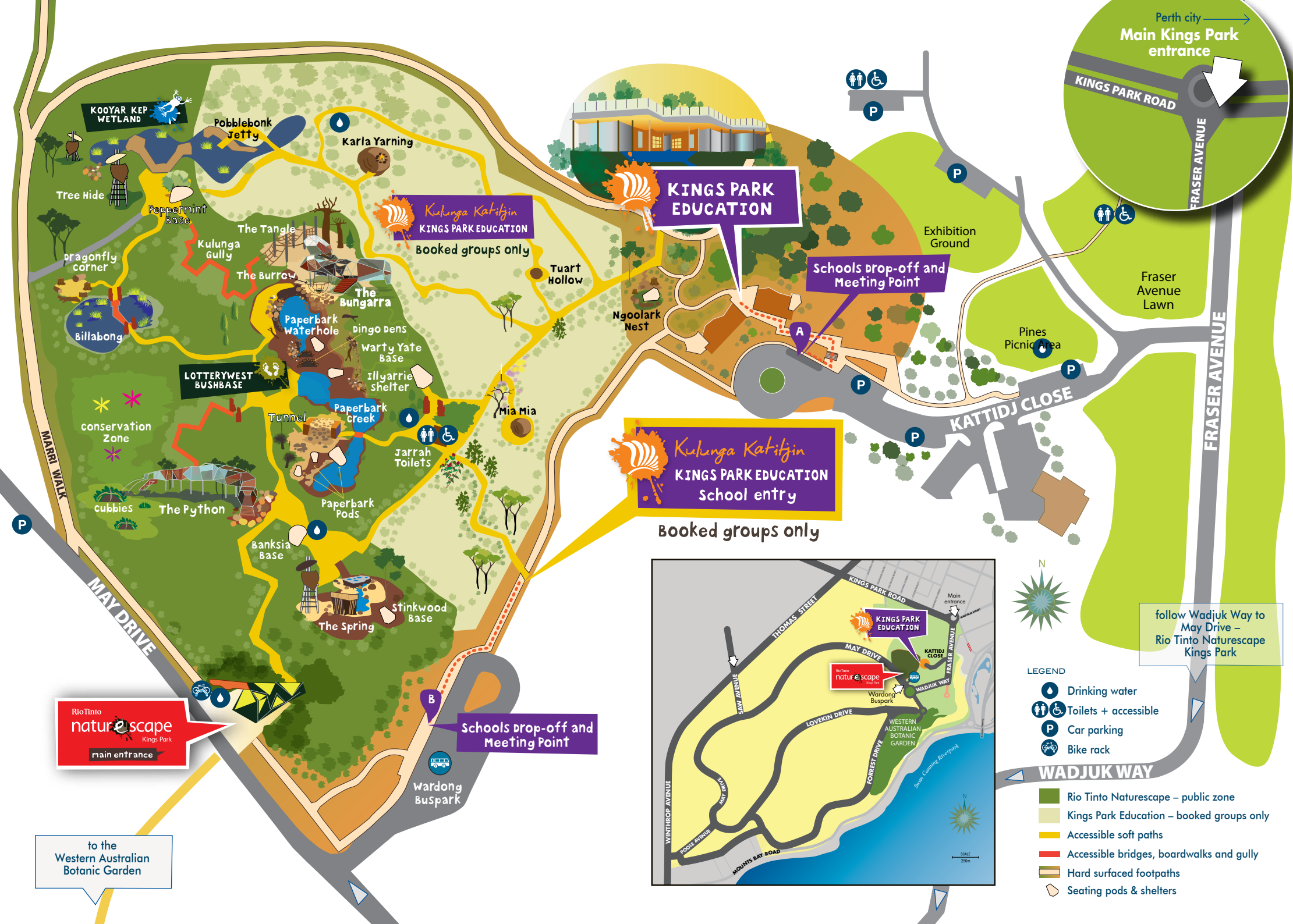
